

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q. Will Gaiagen's Wild Animal Repellent harm my cattle and pets?

- No, this product will not harm your cattle & your pets. In case an animal were to bite on the mode of application (rope), it will leave a bad taste in their mouth.

Q. What materials do I require for the application of Gaiagen's Wild Animal Repellent?

- To carry out the application of this product, you will require...
 - A pair of hand gloves & a face mask
 - Stakes for making a perimeter fence
 - Water for mixing
 - Loosely woven jute with a diameter of 5mm or more
- Or choir rope with a diameter of 100 mm or more
 - 250 to 300 meters of rope needed per acre
 - Drum or a bucket for mixing the solution & soaking the rope

Q. What is the application process for Gaiagen's Wild Animal Repellent?

- Step 1: Add 500 ml of the product to 2.5 liters of water for 1 square acre
- Step 2: Mix well using a long stick as a stirrer
- Step 3: Thoroughly soak jute or coir rope in the mixture for 30 minutes or more
- Step 4: Erect stakes around the perimeter of the area of application
- Step 5: Tie the ropes around the stakes to secure the area

For bison and blue bulls, the secured perimeter must be 3 feet above the ground.

For porcupines and wild boars, the secured perimeter must be 1 foot above the ground.

Q. How many times does the rope have to go around the perimeter during the application?

- It is sufficient for the rope to go around the perimeter once.

Q. Does Gaiagen's Wild Animal Repellent emit an odour?

- Yes, this emits a strong odour that mimics the scent of a large predator. This causes the target pests to stay away from the area of application.

Q. Does this product affect my crops in any way?

- No, Gaiagen's Wild Animal Repellent does not affect crops. If sprayed on plants they may cause phototoxicity. In some cases, plants may show burn-like symptoms.

Q. Do other wild animals get attracted to the scent of this product?

- No, Gaiagen's Wild Animal Repellent does not attract other wild animals.

Q. Does this product work in dry and arid conditions?

- Yes, Gaiagen's Wild Animal Repellent works in dry and arid conditions. You may have to spray water on the rope once every few days in case the rope dries to reactivate the active ingredient.



Q. Can I use any other material to create my boundaries?

- Though you can use any material that can absorb the dilution and release it slowly, it is advised to use jute rope (diameter 5mm or more) or choir rope (diameter 10 mm or more). Repellency will depend on the material used.

Q. Can I control multiple pests by using the same boundary?

- That depends on the height at which you have secured the perimeter. A rope soaked in the solution and secured at the height of 3 feet will keep away bison, blue bulls and other large grazing animals. However, smaller animals will get past into a field from under the perimeter.

Similarly, a perimeter secured at a height of 1 foot will repel small animals like wild boars and porcupines, but might allow field access to larger animals who would simply walk over the rope.

Multiple applications might be required in case a field is prone to risks from varied wildlife.

Q. Can I use Gaiagen's Wild Animal Repellent around a plantation that does not have a defined boundary?

- Most certainly. Simply erect stakes and secure all animal entry and exit points with a rope soaked in the prepared solution. Gaiagen's Wild Animal Repellent can also be used to secure other areas where human-wildlife conflict is most likely to happen.
